You will not commit adultery. You will not steal.





Verse 19-20 "And when the LORD saw it, he abhorred them, because of the provoking of his sons, and of his daughters. And he said, I will hide my face from them, I will see what their end shall be: for they are a very froward generation, children in whom is no faith." Faith is dying out in this country and even many of God's people have returned to the world. Just like in the days of Noah, many of God's people were leaving the worship of the Lord to follow their own lusts and desires. I believe that after the Supreme Court voted to legalize same sex marriages, that God turned His face from this nation. Not away from His children, but away from those who do not want to serve Him. Since that vote was made the disasters upon this nation have increased and will continue to grow until man repents. Without God's protection around this nation, we are subject to the prince and power of this world.

Verse 25 "The sword without, and terror within, shall destroy both the young man and the virgin, the suckling also with the man of gray hairs." Matthew 6:30-34 "Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, shall he not much more clothe you, O ye of little faith? Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed? (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things. But <u>seek</u> <u>ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness</u>; and all these things shall be added unto you. Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof."

We need to believe that He will take care of us. It takes great faith. We need to seek His wisdom and understanding, learning how to walk according to His will. If we can put His will above everything else in our lives, then there will be nothing we won't be able to do in His name. And we won't have to worry about anything that might happen to us.

There's a story in the bible that makes me think about how important it is to trust in Him when there are storms around us.

Mark 4:35-40 "And the same day, when the even was come, he saith unto them, Let us pass over unto the other side. And when they had sent away the multitude, they took him even as he was in the ship. And there were also with him other little ships. <u>And there</u> <u>arose a great storm of wind, and the waves beat into</u> <u>the ship, so that it was now full.</u> And he was in the hinder part of the ship, asleep on a pillow: and they awake him, and say unto him, Master, carest thou not that we perish? And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And he said unto them, <u>Why are ye so fearful? how is it that ye have no</u> <u>faith?"</u>

We will face great storms in our lives and the wind and the waves of the world will beat against us and it will feel like we are sinking with no hope of relief at times. Jesus was there in that sinking ship with them just like He is always with us, even in times when life seems hopeless. And during those times He is asking us, "What are you afraid of? Where is your faith?"

We have His promise to always be with us. Matthew 28:20 "*Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, <u>I am with</u> <u>you alway</u>, even unto the end of the world. Amen."*

But we must believe Him. Take time to build your faith by getting to know Him through study of His Word and through prayer. (Continued on Last Page.)
