OUR YES AND NO ATTITUDE

What do I mean by our yes and no attitude? Well, what I'm going to write about today involves clean & unclean meat according to God's Word. Many times, Christians know the answer but feel they will hurt someone's feelings, or what difference could it make, or if we don't ask we won't know. Some people, even in the church may not be convinced that the law of clean & unclean applies to you and me today, and there are many false prophets teaching that the Laws of God are not to be kept.

How would you answer someone teaching false doctrine on this subject? Many would say, this law isn't important, or some verses in the Bible are not clear dealing with this subject. I want to relate what I heard one minister say on this subject the other day, up front, he is protestant, and wrong.

I came into his sermon as he was going through Acts 10:10-17. He said God was reading to Peter that he could enjoy a ham sandwich, pork chops, fried shrimp, barbecue pork ribs. Then he said that when Peter was eating with the Gentiles in Galatians 2:11-21; that Peter, probably was wiping barbecue sauce off his mouth as the Jews came in and he moved away from them. Then Paul, seeing Peter doing this, let loose with both barrels, because Peter was wanting to go back into that old law that he had just came out of. Now that is the gist of what this man said. How would you answer him, or would you see this as a remarkable explanation? Some in the church, I'm afraid, would agree with this man.

being taught by this man.

Let's go to Acts 10:9, "on the next day, as they were on their way and approaching the city, Peter went up on the housetop about the sixth hour to pray. (10) But he became hungry and was desiring to eat; but while they were making preparations, he fell into a trance, (11) and he saw the sky opened up, and an object like a great sheet coming down, lowered by four corners to the ground. (12) and there were in it all kinds of four-footed animals and crawling creatures of the earth and birds of the air (13) a voice came to him, 'Get up and eat!' (14) But Peter said, "By no means, Lord, for I have never eaten anything unholy and unclean. Three times this vision came to Peter."

So let's think about this a little. We see here that Peter, who knew God's law concerning clean and unclean meats and he had never violated those laws. He did know that God wouldn't violate His own laws, so what was the meaning? Well, verse 15 tells us what God has cleaned, and is no longer considered unholy.

So, we must think on this. Was God telling Peter that Christ died to clean up the unclean meats? Could Jesus actually have died so mankind could eat without sinning whatever he wishes to? This is the message of the sermon I heard.

Folks, Jesus Christ, the Son of the living God, did not die for animals, or for human beings to eat the scavengers of this world. Jesus Christ died to clean human beings up, to remove the sins of this world. He died to provide us human beings, God's greatest creation, the opportunity to be part of His family and live forever.

What, in fact, was God trying to tell Peter by these verses? In verse 28 of Acts chapter 10 we see what the problem was. (28) "And He said to them, 'vou vourselves know how unlawful it is for a man who is a Jew to associate with a foreigner or to visit him; and yet God has shown me that I should not call any man unholy or unclean." You see, according to Jewish law, not God's law, Jews were forbidden to associate with Gentiles. God was telling Peter by the vision that he was not to do this. (34) "opening his mouth, Peter said: "I most certainly understand now that God is not one to show partiality (35) but in every nation the man who fears Him and does what is right is welcome to Him." We clearly see how that minister I heard, hadn't read or hadn't believed the rest of the chapter! Food was not the issue, people were.

To many people the laws of the Old Covenant were the laws of the Jews. It applied to them only, with the food laws being one of them. But let's see how we can prove that they existed before there were any Jews. Before Abraham, clean and unclean meats were known.

Let's go to Genesis 7:1 "Then the Lord said to Noah enter the ark, you and all your household, for you alone I have seen to be righteous before Me in their time. (2) You shall take with you of every clean animal by sevens, a male and his female; and of the animals that are not clean two, a male and his female. (3) also of the birds of the sky, by sevens, male and female, to keep offspring alive on the face of all the earth."

So, we can prove that as much as 1500 years before any Jews, the laws of God regarding clean and unclean meats were taught and observed.

So, when we are faced with eating or not eating foods that contain meat that God tells us not to eat, the decision should be easy. We must obey God's words or it's sin. Deuteronomy chapter 14 tells mankind what animals, birds and fish that are good to eat and which ones that are not to be eaten. But remember law breaking people will still preach or obey a preacher who teaches that they know better than God. Don't believe them. The father of lies is behind them.

I hope this helps you to better understand and to be better able to correct false doctrine on this subject. END
