


We can find many of the curses for sin written in Deuteronomy 28:15-68 and Leviticus 26:14-39. Please take time to read them.

Please send our love to all our brothers and sisters, our church family there in Missouri and the U.S.A. God bless you all. Our bible training school was closed for a time because of the Covid-19 pandemic, but the students are all staying active and are faithfully serving the Lord. They are always there to help in all the church activities and soul winning programs. We are now conducting a leadership seminar in Cebu, in Hilltop and in our main church in Cagayan de Oro City to raise up leaders for the future. All is going well here although there are places here under general community quarantine and many under lockdown with restrictions. But so far the spreading of the gospel is still going well. We are looking forward to our convention in the first week of November. We need your prayers for this. The Lord blesses the work here continually and souls are coming into the church despite the pandemic. The Lord continues to work with us and keeps us from all harm. Hallelujah! To God be the glory. She is in the hospital after having surgery where they put a rod in her leg. They will not release her until the bill for services and medicine have been paid.

Pastor Martin is still conducting services over the air at a radio station. It is reaching a lot of people and more are wanting to come into the church family. This increases the needs of the churches, but this is what we call a good problem. They are all thankful for your support and prayers. (Where is God when I'm Suffering?, Continued from Page 4.) if God has abandoned them.

I will say for certain that the answer is a big, NO. God never turns His back on His children. The Apostle Paul, in Romans 8:38-39, said this: "For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord."

God places a hedge of protection around His children, just like the one Satan said was around Job. Job 1:10 "Hast not thou made an hedge about him, and about his house, and about all that he hath on every side? thou hast blessed the work of his hands, and his substance is increased in the land."

No one can get through that hedge unless the Father allows it. Now with that said, then what is the answer to why we suffer?

God's hedge will keep others out, but will not keep us in if we choose to separate ourselves from the Father. When we turn our back on Him and begin to walk contrary to Him, we are walking outside that hedge. God then will allow us to suffer enough to try to turn us back to Him, as a form of correction. The more we resist, the more we may struggle and suffer as He works to lead us to repentance and to returning.

In Job's case, God called him righteous, but yet He allowed Satan to test him. In the first test of Job's faith and commitment to God, Satan was allowed to take away Job's possessions and family, but was not allowed to harm him. Job 1:12 "And the LORD said unto Satan, Behold, all that he hath is in thy power; only upon himself put not forth thine hand. So Satan went forth from the presence of the LORD."

But, Job didn't curse God, he praised Him instead. Job 1:20-22 "Then Job arose, and rent his mantle, and shaved his head, and fell down upon the ground, and worshipped, And said, Naked came I out of my mother's womb, and naked shall I return thither: the LORD gave, and the LORD hath taken away; blessed be the name of the LORD. In all this Job sinned not, nor charged God foolishly."

Job had just lost everything except his wife. Of course he grieved, but he remained true to God, knowing that everything he had came from the Lord.

I wonder how many of us could do the same if we were tested like that?

When Satan saw how Job reacted, the devil approached the Lord again. The Lord bragged to Satan about Job, and said he was a perfect and an upright man. The Lord also reminded Satan that Job had passed the test that was put upon him. In reading the following verses, we can see that Lord tells Satan that He didn't appreciate the devil's accusations.

Job 2:2-3 "And the LORD said unto Satan, From whence comest thou? And Satan answered the LORD, and said, From going to and fro in the earth, and from walking up and down in it. And the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that there is none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil? and still he holdeth fast his integrity, although thou movedst me against him, to destroy him without cause."

Now Satan wasn't through. Job 2:4-5 "And Satan answered the LORD, and said, Skin for skin, yea, all that a man hath will he give for his life. But put forth thine hand now, and touch his bone and his flesh, and he will curse thee to thy face."

Satan was accusing Job of being willing to give up everything, including his family to save his own life.

Job 2:6-8 "And the LORD said unto Satan, Behold, he is in thine hand; but save his life. So went Satan forth from the presence of the LORD, and smote Job with sore boils from the sole of his foot unto his crown. And he took him a potsherd to scrape himself withal; and he sat down among the ashes."

The Lord knew that Job was strong enough to get through what was about to happen to him or He wouldn't have even mentioned Job to Satan. Did the Lord know how Job would react to this situation. No. But, he knew Job's strength and he wouldn't have tested him beyond what He knew Job could handle.

I Corinthians 10:13 "There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it."

God had not abandoned Job. He was still protecting his life. He had only opened the hedge enough to allow Satan to try Job.

He treats us the same way by allowing His children to face different trials in the hope to make our faith stronger.

We don't know how long Job suffered, but he stayed strong even when things looked grim and even while three of his friends gave him no support. He trusted God with his life even if he would die.

This is just one story of many in the bible that show us the trials of God's people. God never abandoned His people in any of these trials.

As you and I draw closer to the Lord, we can be sure that we will face trials. If we meet these trials knowing that God is with us, and that He will never abandon us, then we will be able to overcome any trial and temptation that we might face in our life. END
