themselves may have been born the wrong gender. They are told that instead of being a boy you may be a girl or the other way around.

God's Word says something completely different. In 1 Corinthians 6:9 it says that homosexuals would not inherit the Kingdom of God. In Genesis 1:27 "God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him male and female He created them." So, God didn't create something in between the two sexes, He created them one or the other.

There are many more attacks on our beliefs. We find that so called churches are embracing these ideas and many others that are contrary to God's Law. When faced with this pressure from society and loved ones, yes, maybe even from the church, how should we react? Jesus as I've noted, stood up and told them the truth. He never compromised. Another good example of not compromising, was Daniel. Also, there with Daniel was Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego.

The king had planned to educate these young men and put them into his service in Babylon. The king, however, had also planned for these young men to eat a special diet, his own diet.

Daniel 1:8-9 "But Daniel purposed in His heart that he would not defile himself with the king's choice food or with wine which he drank, so he sought permission from the commander of the officials that he might not defile himself. "Now God granted Daniel favor and compassion in the sight of the commander of the officials." Here we have Daniel taking the lead by already having decided not to violate God's food laws. In this same situation how would you or I have reacted?

I see people all the time not keeping God's law and then giving "reasons" excuses as to why they can't do it. Daniel could have compromised, but he didn't. Daniel in 1:12-15 says "please test your servants for ten days, and let us be given some vegetables to eat and water to drink. Then let our appearance be observed in your presence and the appearance of the youths who are eating the kings choice foods, and deal with your servants according to what you see. So he listened to them in this matter and tested them for ten days. At the end of ten days their appearance seemed better and they were fatter than all the youths who had been eating the Kings choice foods."

So, we see here that Daniel and the other three, chose to follow God's laws in a situation that could have cost them their lives. God gave them favor, and later in their lives God was able to use them again.

Remember that Daniel was thrown in the lion's den, while the other three were thrown in the fiery furnace for standing firm in their beliefs and trust in God.

This should be an example for each of us, that during these uncertain times, we may be asked to stand up for the truth, and by us doing so, then God can use us for even greater things.

However, we are required to endure to the end no matter what. Mark 13:13 "And you will be hated by all for My name's sake. But he who endures to the end shall be saved."

Remember God will never leave us nor forsake us. Matthew 28:20 "teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen." END
