Are You Talking to Me?

it is manifest that he (God) is excepted, which did put all things under him." (Emphasis mine.)


Now we can see who appeared and spoke to the patriarchs and prophets of old.

He walked in the garden with Adam, told Noah to build an ark, met with Abraham in the form of a man, wrestled with Jacob, just to name a few ways He conversed with man. He spoke to Moses on Mt. Sinai, in front of the tabernacle of congregation as a cloudy pillar. Exodus 33:10-11 "And all the people saw the cloudy pillar stand at the tabernacle door: and all the people rose up and worshipped, every man in his tent door. And the LORD spake unto Moses face to face, as a man speaketh unto his friend."

He tried to speak to Israel, but they told Moses to stand between them and the Lord, and to speak for Him. Exodus 20:18-19 "And all the people saw the thunderings, and the lightnings, and the noise of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking: and when the people saw it, they removed, and stood afar off. And they said unto Moses, Speak thou with us, and we will hear: but let not God speak with us, lest we die."

He continued to speak to Moses face to face, but that changed when Joshua was given charge of Israel.

Now we have to understand what a prophet is. A prophet is someone who speaks the inspired word of God. God spoke to many of the prophets in visions and dreams, and many like Daniel, Isaiah, Ezekiel and Jeremiah, just to name a few, were shown future events. Many of King David's psalms are prophecies.

In his letter dated February 21st, 2022, Pastor Nestor wrote: "Love and greetings to all of you our dearly beloved in the Lord, from all of us here in the Philippines, in the Name f Jesus, the Christ. Hope you are all fine and richly blessed by our Heavenly Father. May He keep you all safe. Amen. We have received your recent letter of December 6th, 2021, with the check for \$300 and good new teachings. It is inspirational and adds to our knowledge about the truth in the Bible. All the pandemics will not end until the world will repent. The main factor for tragedy and troubles including this pandemic is sin.

About the gospel and mission works here still continue. The Lord continues working with us and keeps us always from all harm. Nothing can hinder the work of God and the Lord blesses the works continually despite the many hardships. Our place is now under a state of calamity due to typhoon "Odette," that caused flash flooding and landslides. Some of our churches and people were affected especially in Cebu. Thank God we are all safe. Praise the Lord. The first Sabbath of March 2022 will be our 22nd KC Church of God Thanksgiving anniversary (See photos below). We need your prayers. And on April 2nd 2022 is our KC Church of God Thanksgiving anniversary in Cantipla, Cebu City."

In his letter dated March 14th, 2022, he wrote: "We are now all OK after the Super typhoon hit our place. We need for now more funds to buy building materials to repair our church building. We hope and believe that the Lord will supply all our needs. About the gospel and mission work here it is still fine and really good. The Lord keeps us safe as we go everywhere preaching the gospel and keeps us strong. We feel the joy of serving the Lord more than words can say, and it drives away our pain and tears as we see souls being saved as the fruit of our labor. Hallelujah.! To God be the glory. The work continues growing and churches stay active and strong in the Lord amidst the pandemics. On April 1st 2022 we will be leaving for Cebu to attend our KC Church of God church Thanksgiving anniversary and will stay there for many days to help pastor Nelson and the team in spreading the gospel. We need your prayers."

In his letter dated April 11th, 2022, he wrote: "We have received your letter with the check for \$300, newsletters and DVD's. Thank you so much. Just yesterday again we were hit by a typhoon named "Agaton." Lives were lost and property damaged. Today, typhoon "Agaton" is in Visayas, and Cebu city is severely damaged. But we thank God we are safe. What we need most now are building materials for our church building repair in Hilltop and Cagayan de Oro City. Cebu church had no damage. Our 9th annual Thanksgiving in Cebu city last April 2nd was very successful. We are also blessed. All of us enjoy so much hearing each testimony, Bible study, and praise and worship. Thank you for sending me such blessed and wonderful Bible lessons about "All things new." I can use it and share it in churches and Bible school. I baptized one precious soul during our Thanksgiving anniversary in Cebu. The camera you sent to me was damaged because of the typhoon and it won't work anymore. We love you Stephen and Teresa and all there. Thank you all so much for all your support. Thank you for being with us in spirit and in prayer. We keep you always in our thoughts and prayers. We love you. Hallelujah! To God be the glory. God bless you all and God Bless America. Sincerely yours in Christ, your brother and sister, and fellow servants, Nestor and Edith."

(Are You Talking to Me?, Continued from Page 4.) was upon him. And it was revealed unto him by the Holy Spirit, that he should not see death, before he had seen the Lord's Christ. And he came by the Spirit into the temple: and when the parents brought in the child Jesus, to do for him after the custom of the law. Then took he him up in his arms, and blessed God, and said, Lord, now lettest thou thy servant depart in peace, according to thy word: For mine eyes have seen thy salvation, Which thou hast prepared before the face of all people; A light to lighten the Gentiles, and the glory of thy people Israel. And Joseph and his mother marvelled at those things which were spoken of him. And Simeon blessed them, and said unto Mary his mother, Behold, this child is set for the fall and rising again of many in Israel; and for a sign which shall be spoken against; (Yea, a sword shall pierce through thy own soul also,) that the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed."

Acts 13:1 "Now there were in the church that was at Antioch certain prophets and teachers; as Barnabas, and Simeon that was called Niger, and Lucius of Cyrene, and Manaen, which had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch, and Saul."

These prophets spoke the inspired word of God as it was given to them by the Holy Spirit.

The Apostle Phillip had daughters that prophesied. Acts 21:8-9 "And the next day we that were of Paul's company departed, and came unto Caesarea: and we entered into the house of Philip the evangelist, which was one of the seven; and abode with him. And the same man had four daughters, virgins, which did prophesy." The scriptures show us that even women can speak the inspired Word of God, as it is given to them by the Holy Spirit.

The Apostle Paul was taught by Jesus through visions and dreams given to him by the Holy Spirit. 2 Corinthians 12:1-4 "It is not expedient for me doubtless to glory. I will come to visions and revelations of the Lord. I knew a man in Christ above fourteen years ago, (whether in the body, I cannot tell; or whether out of the body, I cannot tell: God knoweth;) such an one caught up to the third heaven. And I knew such a man, (whether in the body, or out of the body, I cannot tell: God knoweth;) How that he was caught up into paradise, and heard unspeakable words, which it is not lawful for a man to utter." Some have said that Paul was speaking of John and his revelation. But this epistle was written in 55-57 AD, so the vision being fourteen years earlier would have been in 41-43 AD.

John's revelation was written in 68-69 AD.

We all know how the Lord gave the Apostle John a vision of the future while he was in the Spirit.

Revelation 1:9-10 "I John, who also am your brother, and companion in tribulation, and in the kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the testimony of Jesus Christ. I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet,"

I wanted to share all of these examples with you in the hope that you will see that God's Holy Spirit still speaks to His saints today, if they will just listen.

1 Corinthians 2:9-12 "But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him. But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God. For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God. Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God."

Our Great Prophet was spoken of by the prophet Moses and other prophets. Acts 3:22-24 "For Moses truly said unto the fathers, A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me; him shall ye hear in all things whatsoever he shall say unto you. And it shall come to pass, that every soul, which will not hear that prophet, shall be destroyed from among the people. Yea, and all the prophets from Samuel and those that follow after, as many as have spoken, have likewise foretold of these days."

By studying the Word of God and asking God for more of His wisdom and understanding, we are asking for inspiration through the Spirit.

Any person with God's Spirit in them who preaches or teaches the inspired word of God is a prophet, or inspired speaker for the Lord. It's not a title to be thrown around, or used for your own edification, but a description of the work being done and the words being spoken.

Our words cannot be inspired, if we are not listening to the Holy Spirit of God.

John 10:27 "My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:" We cannot hear His voice if we are not listening for it.

Is God speaking to us today? The answer is "YES." The real question is are we listening? Make time to be quiet, still and listen. END
