You will not steal.

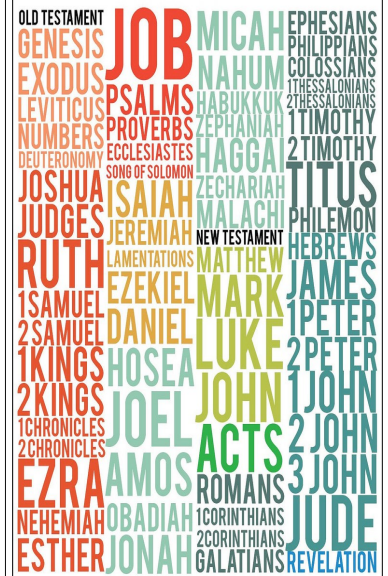
You will not bear false witness against your neigh-

Crossing the Finish Line

Philippians 1:3-6 Paul says, *"I thank my God upon every remembrance of you, always in every prayer of mine making request for you all with joy, for your fellowship in the gospel from the first day until now, being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ;"* What Paul is saying is that God will not let go of us, and that He will be with us until Jesus returns.

Paul says it this way in Romans 8:37-39, *"Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord,"* and in Hebrews 13:5, *"...For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." Paul was quoting Deuteronomy 31:6-8 here.*

Jesus gave us a warning about the end of the age, the times I believe we are living in now. In Matthew 24:13 Jesus said, *"But he who endures to the end shall be saved."* I believe Jesus was speaking of the

fact that many people would fall away from the faith as the Apostle Paul said in 2 Thessalonians 2:2-4, *"not to be soon shaken in mind or troubled, either by spirit or by word or by letter, as if from us, as though the day of Christ had come. Let no one deceive you by any means; for that Day will not come unless the falling away comes first, and the man of sin is revealed, the son of perdition,"*

One of the lessons we must learn as God's people is that we only win if we cross the finish line. For us, that's being in the Kingdom of God.

Paul says in 1 Corinthians 9:24-27, *"Do you not know that those who run in a race all run, but one receives the prize? Run in such a way that you may obtain it. And everyone who competes for the prize is temperate in all things. Now they do it to obtain a perishable crown, but we for an imperishable crown. Therefore I run thus: not with uncertainty. Thus I fight: not as one who beats the air. But I discipline my body and bring it into subjection, lest, when I have preached to others, I myself should become disqualified."*

Now I do not want anyone to think that any little mistake we make will disqualify us. No way am I saying that, but a little bit of leaven leavens the whole lump. We must be aware of (Continued on Page 4.)

sin, false doctrine or whatever we may do or not do that takes our eyes off the prize, or we can fall from grace over time.

In Hebrews 12:1-3, Paul says, *“Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. For consider Him who endured such hostility from sinners against Himself, lest you become weary and discouraged in your souls.”*

We truly face many trials in this life. God knew this and led Paul to write in Philippians 2:16, *“holding fast the word of life, so that I may rejoice in the day of Christ that I have not run in vain or labored in vain.”* Paul was clearly led to understand that we live a life of overcoming.

In Matthew 10:22, Jesus said, *“You will be hated by all because of My name, but it is the one who has endured to the end who will be saved.”* Again, Jesus says that we must endure.

Paul wrote that we are examples for others in 2 Corinthians 3:2-4, *“You are our epistle written in our hearts, known and read by all men; clearly you are an epistle of Christ, ministered by us, written not with ink but by the Spirit of the living God, not on tablets of stone but on tablets of flesh, that is, of the heart. And we have such trust through Christ toward God.”*

Paul wrote in 1 Timothy 6:11-12, *“But you, O man of God, flee these things and pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, gentleness. Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, to which you were also called and have confessed the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.”*

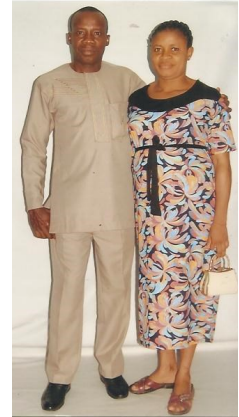
We must hang on to Christ and not grow weary, even in the worst of trials, and always remember we must cross the finish line. END

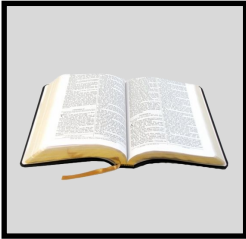
